

Poachers Pre65 Classic Trials Club
Round 3 Club Championship 19th April 26

64 Riders signed on for our re-scheduled visit to Syston for 8 sections set over 5 laps, dry conditions meant a low scoring round for almost half the entry finishing on nail-biting single figures, four of that number over the three routes managed not to drop a single mark.

The trial was set in two halves with sections one to four set in the bowl at the top end of the venue, (see John's video on YouTube: Engtec Trials) riders then crossed over to valley that held the remaining four sections. The Trial was set out by Mark Francis, Shane Lockley, John Guy, and Steve Manning. The results show a very similar total marks lost for each route, which indicates that each route was set just about right, challenging but nothing dangerous.

Again, we thank Ian Wilkinson for organizing a full complement of observers for Sunday, names and sections listed on the bottom of page 3 of the results. Our next Trial is back in the Wolds with a visit back to Biscathorpe Park on the 10th of May, last used on the Poachers Bag Road Trial we hope to be able to find 10 sections at this excellent venue.

Entries should be open on Thursday 23rd and that makes it just over two weeks before the Trial, so if you could get your entries over to me as soon as possible that would help the admin process.
